- Collaboration with local health authorities to provide updated information and resources to the community.



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Report on Kabasura Kudineer Program by NSS Unit at RAAK Arts and Science College

Date: November 16, 2020

Venue: Villianur Temple Surrounding, Puducherry

Organized by: NSS Unit, RAAK Arts and Science College

Objective:
