

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Report on World Environment Day



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Report on Blood Donation Camp

Date: 07/07/2022

Collaboration: Villianur Government Hospital (GH)

Introduction

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of RAAK Arts and Science College organized a Blood Donation Camp on July 7, 2022, in collaboration with Villianur Government Hospital. The camp aimed to promote the importance of blood donation among students and staff while contributing to the local healthcare system.

Objectives

1. To create awareness about the need for regular blood donation.
2. To encourage students and staff to participate in the noble cause of saving lives.
3. To support the Villianur GH in maintaining a sufficient blood supply for emergencies.

Planning and Preparation

Outcomes


- **Successful Plantation:** 200 saplings were planted, contributing to the green cover in the Lawspet area.

- **Expansion of the Program:** Organize similar tree plantation drives in other areas of the community.


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

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Report on HIV/AIDS Awareness Program

The program was meticulously planned with the involvement of health professionals and educators. Key aspects of the preparation included:

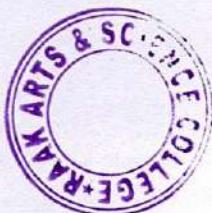
