Introduction:

On 12.06.2019, students from RAAK Arts and Science college conducted a cleaning drive at Pondicherry Bus stand. This initiative aimed to promote environmental cleanliness, instill civic responsibility among students, and improve the hygiene of a heavily frequented public space.

Event Details:

The drive began at 8:00 Am, with 140 students from various Department participating. Under the guidance of M.KUMARAGURU students were divided into teams and equipped with cleaning supplies such as gloves, brooms, dustpans, and trash bags. Key Activities:


Recommendations:




