



Eligibility for Under Graduate Arts, Commerce and Science program - A pass in the higher Secondary examination of the (10+2) curriculum (academic stream) prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu or any other examination equivalent there to with minimum of 45% marks (40% marks for OBC/ MBC and SC/ST candidates) in aggregate of subjects- Mathematics, Physics and any one of the following optional subjects: Chemistry /Biotechnology/Computer Science/Biology (Botany & Zoology), Commerce/Accountancy or an examination of any UGC recognized University

Eligibility for Post Graduate Arts, Commerce, Science and Management program – A pass in Bachelor Degree (10+2+3 pattern) in arts, science or management program
